

Packing list

In addition to all the basics that you will pack, here is a list of suggested items that may make your time on tour with us even more enjoyable:

Clothing

- □ A mix of breathable long-sleeve and short-sleeve shirts. Merino wool shirts are very light and dry quickly! Out of respect for the local culture, it is recommended that you do not wear shirts that expose your shoulders while visiting temples and religious sites.
- □ Breathable pants or shorts that convert into pants (perfect for rainy days or if insects are bothersome)
- ☐ A sun hat or cap
- ☐ A light rain jacket (just in case!)
- \square Comfortable walking shoes

Documents

- ☐ Plane tickets
- □ Passport
- □ Printed copy of your Vietnam e-Visa
- ☐ Driver's licence
- □ Photocopies of your passport and driver's licence
- ☐ Travel insurance confirmation of coverage
- ☐ List of any medications and allergies you may have
- ☐ Emergency phone numbers
- ☐ Original prescriptions (for refills and for border security)
- ☐ Your fancy Tour Journal!

Recommended carry-on items

Essentials

(that we sometimes forget)

- □ Sunglasses
- ☐ Sunscreen (SPF 30+)
- ☐ Insect repellent (such as Watkins or OFF!)
- ☐ Ear plugs
- □ Wallet + credit cards + cash (no traveller's cheques – few places accept them now!)
- ☐ Camera + memory cards
- ☐ Cell phone/tablet
- ☐ Headphones/earbuds
- ☐ International power adapter
- ☐ Chargers for electronic devices (camera, cell phone, tablet)
- ☐ Medications in their original prescription bottles
- ☐ Basic First Aid items (Gravol, Band-Aids, alcohol wipes, acetaminophen or ibuprofen, antacids, tweezers, After Bite, antihistamines, loperamide, lip balm)
- ☐ Your favourite book or magazine
- ☐ Hand sanitizer
- ☐ A collapsible / compact umbrella (easy to slip into your check-in luggage)
