DAYS 1 & 2 • GOODBYE CANADA, BOM DIA PORTUGAL!

Enjoy a private car ride to the airport. Fly to Lisbon where you'll meet your Group Guru and fellow travellers. Upon your arrival, our luxury coach takes you to your hotel to settle in, before a welcome cocktail. Overnight in Lisbon. (L,D)

DAY 3 • DISCOVER LISBON & BELÉM

Spend the morning drawn in by the bohemian neighbourhoods of Bairro Alto and Chiado. Explore the pedestrian avenues around Comércio Square, Rossio Square and the winding Alfama district. Experience authentic local cooking with a Pastéis de Bacalhau workshop, then follow the soft ocean breeze to Belém tower and the Age of Discoveries. Stop for a tasting of Pastéis de Belém, a local institution famous for its take on the sumptuous custard-filled pastel de nata. We promise your first bite won't be your last! After a visit to the Jerónimos Monastery, enjoy some free time to explore Lisbon or join us for an optional visit to the Royal Coaches Museum. Overnight in Lisbon. (B,L,D)

DAY 4 • CORK OBSERVATORY & NATIONS PARK

Make your way to Coruche for a visit to the Cork Observatory. After lunch visit the Parque das Nações neighborhood of Lisbon, a redeveloped area known for the striking Camões Theatre and Lisbon Oceanarium. Amble around Lisbon at your leisure or join us for a tour of the Oceanarium, the largest indoor aquarium in Europe. Overnight in Lisbon. (B,L,D)

DAY 5 • DAY TRIP TO SINTRA, CABO DA ROCA & CASCAIS

Fairytale Sintra is home to exotic gardens and exquisite palaces. Appreciate the Moorish architecture of Palácio Nacional before reaching Cabo da Roca, the striking viewpoint forming Europe's westernmost point. A relaxing afternoon tour takes you through the scenic resort town of Cascais. Overnight in Lisbon. (B,L,D)

DAY 6 • MEDIEVAL ÓBIDOS & ROUTE TO PORTO (350 KM)

Walking tour of the medieval village of Óbidos, initially a Roman settlement during the peak of the empire. Enjoy seaside scenery in the resort towns of Nazaré and Batalha, where you will visit the famous Batalha Monastery, built in 1386. Overnight in Porto. (B,L,D)

DAY 7 • TASTE PORTO

The colourful Baroque-influenced city of Porto will tickle your senses. Visit the Stock Exchange Palace, the Sao Bento train station, & the lively Ribeira Square. Tour a leading port wine cellar, and learn about its unique production method before partaking in a deliciously orchestrated tasting. Spend the rest of the day exploring at your own pace. Overnight in Porto. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 • WINE TASTING & DOURO CRUISE (272 KM)

On to the town of Vila Real to explore its Casa Mateus gardens before sitting down for wine tasting in a Lamego winery. Set off on a river cruise from the port town of Pinhão and glide along the scenic Douro Valley. Overnight in Porto. (B,L,D)



DAY 9 • AVEIRO & COIMBRA (140 KM)

Enjoy a panoramic tour of the canal quarter of Aveiro, the "Venice of Portugal". On to history-filled Coimbra to discover its Moorish-era city center as well as its spectacular medieval university, dating back to 1290. Overnight in Coimbra. (B,L,D)

DAY 10 • TOMAR, KNIGHTS TEMPLAR & SETÚBAL (250 KM)

Explore the city of Tomar, former seat of the Knights Templar. Visit the Convent of Christ, a former Catholic convent that acted as one of the headquarters of the Knights Templar until 1314. Continue to the seaside city of Setúbal where you will spend the night. (B,L,D)

DAY 11 • DISCOVER SETÚBAL

Start your day with a guided tour of Setúbal before discovering the rich history behind the production of queijo de azeitão, a creamy and flavourful cheese that hails from the region of Azeitão. Overnight in Setúbal. (B,L,D)

DAY 12 • WINE TASTING & LAGOS (279 KM)

Enjoy a guided tour and wine tasting in a traditional Monsaraz cellar before heading south to the beautiful seaside resort town Lagos, in the Algarve region. Overnight in Lagos. (B,L,D)

DAY 13 • LAGOS & PONTA DA PIEDADE (188 KM)

Day trip to the most southwestern point of Europe. Visit Cabo São Vicente before embarking on a tour of Lagos. After exploring the Slave Market Museum and seeing the statue of Prince Henry the Navigator, channel your inner explorer with a scenic boat ride from Lagos to Ponta da Piedade. Discover crystal-clear water leading to a series of unique, jagged coastline arches and caves carved by the ocean over thousands of years. Spend the rest of the day exploring the beaches of Lagos at your own pace. Overnight in Lagos. (B,L,D)

DAY 14 • LAGOS WANDERLUST

Discover the beaches on this idyllic coastline at your own pace or join us on a walk on the cliffs of Lagos. Lagos is a favourite for tourists and locals alike – the perfect place to relax, enjoy the sun and sample tasty Portuguese specialties. Overnight in Lagos. (B,L,D)


